Skibbereen Farm has lots to do for your horse enthusiast ... especially more opportunities for them to spend time at the barn.

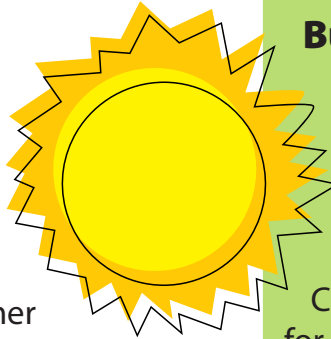
Summer Camp is coming!!! Sign up for summer camp online today!! Learn more about horses during our day camps. Camps start July 7.

**PAYMENT POLICY REMINDER**

Summer also brings a busy lesson schedule. Just a reminder about our **payment policy**. All lesson students are required to pay for their monthly lessons on the first lesson day of the month for the entire month. Students are required to take a minimum of 4 lessons per month. You are paying for your lesson slot; NOT by attendance.

Just a safety reminder about **dress code**. Appropriate foot wear is mandatory in the barns - no flip flops or sandals. Students should wear full length pants - no shorts. Long hair should be back in ponytail or braided. We thank our older students for being such great role models for our younger riders.
